President hereby makes the following rules to amend the	Directorate of Coordination Police

- 1. Short title and commencement.___ (1) these rules may be called the Directorate of Coordination Police Wireless, (**Director**) Amendment Recruitment Rules 2017.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
