STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP)

Directorate of Coordination Police Wireless, Ministry of Home affairs observing “AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTASAV” and conducting series of events for celebrating the Mahotsav. In this regard, Directorate of Coordination Police Wireless will host “All India Morse Competition” for Police Personnel of States/UTs/CAPFs in the first week of August\* 2022.

**Objective:** To honour Morse operators and upkeep the oldest and reliable means of Radio Communication besides creating awareness and craze for dying out Morse keying based communication skill.

## A) The basic framework of competition:

---

1. Personnel working in the State/UTs Police & CAPFs/CPOs are eligible to participate in the competition.
2. States/UTs/CAPFs/CPOs may depute their best Morse practitioner for the competition to be organized at CPRTI, Vandematram marg, New Delhi on 05<sup>th</sup> August 2022 from 0900 to 1800 hrs subject to Covid-19 situation in Delhi.
3. Winners of Morse Competition will be awarded with Trophy and certificate.
4. Last date for receiving the nomination for National level Morse Competition is 02<sup>nd</sup> August 2022. Nomination received after 02<sup>nd</sup> August 2022 may be rejected.
5. Only one nomination duly authorised by Competent Authority of State/UT/CAPF/CPO will be accepted. Details of nominated candidate as per Annexure-I may be send through signal/email/fax.
6. Candidates will be asked to report to Joint Director (Trg) at CPRTI on 04<sup>th</sup> August 2022 at 1600 hrs.
7. Performance of Morse practitioners will be judged by a Committee/Jury constituted by Director DCPW as below.

8. Committee/Jury may co-opt officials as per requirements for conducting the event.
9. Winner of competition will be declared by Dignitary as per recommendations of Committee/Jury and his decision will be final and binding.



## B) Evaluation Procedure

---

1. **Screening Round:** There will be two screening tests to filter out the participants for main competition. In screening tests participants will be asked to receive a Morse code paragraph to be run over speaker @ 18 WPM & 20 WPM by using appropriate means. Score of 90% is mandatory to pass these rounds\*. Participants not scoring 90% marks will not be allowed to participate in final event. Each round will be scoring 50 marks.
  
2. **Main Competition:** Performance of Morse practitioners will be judged /evaluated in terms of speed and accuracy in Morse sending and reading as per the procedure laid down below:
  - I. **Morse Sending:**

Candidates will be asked to transmit a message containing punctuation signs etc. of 100 words (approx.) in allowed time. Message will be read/received by the designated expert Morse Practitioners for accuracy and accordingly marks will awarded .One mark will be deducted from maximum marks (100) for transmission of each wrong word/mistake.
  
  - II. **Morse Reading:**

Candidates will be asked to hear and read/receive a message of 100 words (approx.) transmitted in Morse code in allowed time. Message read/received by the candidate will be checked for accuracy and accordingly marks will awarded .One mark will be deducted from maximum marks (100) for each mistakes and missing words.

\* Morse sending/receiving speed/time/ message groups can be at jurisdiction of jury if doesn't get sufficient participants for final round.



**Final Marks to decide the performance and rank/place of candidate in Morse championship will be the sum of total marks obtained in Morse reading and sending. (Maximum Marks: 200)**

## **C) Award of Prizes**

---

- 1. A Certificate signed by the Director, DCPW alongwith trophy will be given to the winners (First, Runner&Second Runner).**
- 2. Certificate of participation will be given to all participants taking part in the event at New Delhi.**
- 3. The award ceremony will be organized and the prizes will be awarded by Dignitary.**
